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Information about exams

Exam registration

When you register for a course, you will automatically be registered for the exam.

Confirmation of exam registrations

Please check your exam registrations at the KUnet under the student Self Service system.

Withdrawal from exams

If you decide not to take an exam, please unregister from the exam at the Self Service system at the KUnet.

Please note: You have 3 exam attempts per exam but only 2 of the attempts are placed in the semester.
The 3rd exam attempt will be placed in the coming semester.

Group assignments

You must clearly indicate who is responsible for which parts of the assignment, so the examiner is able to carry out individual assessments.

If this is not respected the assignment will be rejected and you will fail the exam.

BA students can only write in groups with other BA students and MA students can only write in groups with other MA students as there are different format requirements.

Assignments are submitted anonymously

The following assignments are submitted anonymously.

- 3-day compulsory written take home assignment
- free assignment.

Oral exam with or without preparation

This exam takes the form of an individual oral exam. To begin the exam, the student draws a random question prepared by the teacher. The question forms the basis of the oral exam, which also includes a wider discussion of the syllabus, as the examiner is required to assess the student in relation to the entire syllabus. The exam lasts 30 minutes in total, including grading. For oral exams with preparation, the student is given 30 minutes to prepare before the start of the exam.

Oral exams with or without preparation can only be taken individually.

Oral exam based on a synopsis

An oral exam with a synopsis takes the form of an individual oral exam based on a written paper (synopsis). The exam also includes a wider discussion within the syllabus, as the examiner is required to assess the student in relation to the entire syllabus. A synopsis may be written individually or in a group (maximum three persons).

The synopsis may not exceed 7200 keystrokes (three standard pages). In connection with the preparation of a synopsis, the student may use supplementary literature corresponding to up to a maximum of 25% of the syllabus.

Students are examined individually. Group members are not allowed to be present during the examination of the other members of their group.

The assessment is based solely on the oral performance, as the synopsis is not part of the assessment.

Students are allowed to bring to the exam an outline consisting of keywords (max. 100 words) and a synopsis. No comments etc. may be added to the outline and synopsis.

The synopsis and syllabus must be uploaded in the [Digital Exam System](#).

Portfolio exam

The portfolio exam is passed by submitting two compulsory assignments in Absalon during the course.

One overall grade is given based on the two assignments. Students whose assignment is not approved in connection with the first submission deadline are allowed to resubmit a revised assignment once only for assessment by the second submission deadline. To be permitted to resubmit, the student must have submitted an assignment for the first or the second submission (it is not possible to submit a blank paper).

The make-up and resit exam are passed through a free assignment. The free assignment must be submitted in the Digital Exam System.
